On tour he's starred in **Chicago**, **Evita**, **Joseph and The Technicolor Dreamcoat**, **Anything Goes!**, **The Pirates of Penzance**, **Hair**, and **Sunday in the Park with George** (Helen Hayes Award-Best Actor nom.). On film, Viviano starred John Fasano's cult classics **Black Roses** and **The Jitters**. He has also appeared and recorded songs for **Legally Blonde 2**, **Spike of Bensonhurst**, and **Life With Mikey**. Viviano's original cast, compilation, and solo CD recordings number over 70, on a dozen different labels.
